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Does God Equally Love All His Human Children, Inclding His Homosexual Children?

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What you personal believe and why you believe it is a very important element of the human experience. Also, your personal beliefs are very often preferential, subjective and improvable. That's why the word "faith" is often used in the same manner as the word "belief." Your faith is what you believe, and you have faith that what you believe is true. However, what you believe is often based solely upon what you read or hear and then accept it to be the truth. The emphatic truth is that you know very little while you believe very much. And most unfortunately, your personal beliefs are sometimes diametrically opposing to what other people believe. This is the case regarding the evangelical church and the homosexual community. Both sides of this "belief system conflict" have good reasons that support their specific belief system regarding homosexuality. I have pursued the truth regarding this great social conflict, and I've come to believe science provides a significantly more objective, sensible, reasonable and rational understanding of the issue. Basically, science's position is that true homosexuality is a natural occurrence of life. Science is also aware of heterosexual people who willfully engage in homosexual relationships, but these are not true homosexual people.

"This is My Commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you." Lastly, it's important to consider and ponder upon the fundamental democratic principle that is The Law of Equality. This equality means that God loves His homosexual children equally as much as He loves His heterosexual children. You don't have to openly embrace homosexuality, but as a loving Christian (or any other religious affiliation) you must openly accept and lovingly tolerate homosexuality.

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The Proper Sensitivity of Sexual Orientation and Sexual Identity (SO/SI)

Why is it so easy for some people to "pick on" and "bash" another group of people who may be socially isolated by the overall mass of society? Throughout history there's always a minority group who becomes isolated and ostracized by the society's majority. Where's the majority's Brotherly Love and their commitment, devotion and dedication to our great system of American Democracy? And yet, if you stop and think about it, nearly ninety percent of the human experience is common to all Children of Humanity. That little ten percent difference is sufficient for some people to literally murder the society's minority. Why would someone's skin color justify insulting them, punishing them, beating them, or even murdering them? Why would someone's religious affiliation justify insulting them, punishing them, beating them, or even murdering them? And why would someone's SO/SI justify insulting them, punishing them, beating them, or even murdering them? Why would any person or any nation become involved in the creation of second class citizens? Doesn't a nation profit when the nation actively promotes all citizens to be first class citizens, and especially to be optimum citizens?

All sentient human beings desire the same spiritual right and spiritual privilege of being acknowledged, valued, validated and loved for who they truly are – that being the sentient children of the Great Divinity of Democracy. Do we not all long for patience and kindness? Do we not all long for acceptance and belonging? Do we not all long for the concern, care and compassion that's deserving of all sentient life? Do we not all long for the grace, benevolence and love of our Divine Creator? And do we not all long for the faithfulness, fidelity and loyalty of a mature and tolerant society? Lastly, consider this very important question. In a Democratic State which is founded upon Brotherly Love, morality, tolerance, self-discipline, and selfless sacrifice, aren't the rights and privileges afforded to the majority also guaranteed to the minority?

Mankind knows with certainty that unigender citizens are not automatically born as immoral, devious, untrustworthy and unpatriotic citizens. The vast majority of unigender citizens are every bit as moral, honest, trustworthy and patriotic as the vast majority of bigender citizens. Again I say, unigender citizens don't choose their SO/SI. The fact that a unigender person is a homosexual is not their fault, or their mother's fault, or their father's fault, and not even our Creator's fault. I firmly believe homosexuality is dominated by The Law of Fate. Being born male or female is a result of the capricious finger of fate. Being born as a bigender or a unigender is also a result of the capricious finger of fate. And we know with scientific certainty that a person is very highly likely to be born a bigender person versus a unigender person. Accordingly, unigender citizens are a small minority with a highly visible social difference. But that difference doesn't justify ostracizing our unigender citizens, and it certainly doesn't justify denying these good citizens the fair and equitable protection and privileges of the Law of the Land.

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Gays are born with an immense social prejudice against them, being ostracized and condemned for natural occurrences which are beyond anyone's control. And most unfortunately for the gay's parents, society's prejudice also falls upon them. In response to this highly unfair prejudice, let this great truth take root in your heart and mind. No father or mother should ever have any loveless and conactive feelings regarding their unigender child. Surely and truly, both unigender children and bigender children need unconditional acceptance and an unconditional sense of belonging. In addition, unigender children – as compared to bigender children – need just as much parental love, caring, nurturing and understanding. And because of the additional challenges unigender children bare, they actually need more love, caring, nurturing and understanding. And here's another thought that should be considered. Because it takes a village to raise a child, then shouldn't the rest of the village be equally sensitive to the issues and needs of our unigender children?

Being born a unigender person should not be denied or flaunted any more than being born a bigender person should be denied or flaunted. I also believe gays should be equally sensitive to bigender citizens for their natural and normal reactions to homosexuality. To many bigender citizens, certain facets of homosexuality create natural and uncomfortable sensations. This especially applies to bigender men. Let the truth be known that I too am naturally uncomfortable with certain unigender elements. On the other hand, I'm sure there are some unigender persons who are naturally uncomfortable with certain bigender elements. Nevertheless, I'm trying my best to be objective, reasonable, fair, tolerant and loving of the innate essence and nature of my gay sisters and brothers. Again I say, we're all the magnificent children of our gracious, benevolent and loving Creator. Let's all rejoice and be glad for our immeasurable gift of life, our sentient free-will, and all of our fellow sentient sisters and brothers. And this should be embraced and practices whatever one's SO/SI may be. Finally, do you think the Children of Humanity have a sense of SO/SI in the world-to-come? From what I read, many people believe there is no sense of gender in the world-to-come. This means there are no sensations of being male, female, heterosexual or homosexual. I'm sure the Children of Humanity are going to experience a lot of surprises in their gracious Creator's Kingdom of Love.
