Dr. Armand M. Nicholi, Jr.

Dr. Armand M. Nicholi, Jr. is a clinical professor of psychiatry at Harvard Medical School and the Massachusetts General Hospital. Dr. Nicholi has taught a course on Sigmund Freud and C. S. Lewis at Harvard College and the Harvard Medical School for more than 35 years. The course concerns the question of the reality of God, whereby the lecture is presented as an active debate between Sigmund Freud (representing atheism) and C. S. Lewis (representing theism). The arguments presented by both men are derived from their published writings. Dr. Nicholi eventually converted his course into book form, whereby the book's title is "The Question of God: C. S. Lewis and Sigmund Freud Debate God, Love, Sex, and the Meaning of Life." In 2004 PBS produced a two part, four hour TV series of the book, where the series title is "The Question of God." The film is basically biographies of Freud and Lewis with the focus upon the question of the reality of God. The film is also supplemented throughout with Dr. Nicholi hosting a round table discussion among an insightful panel composed of atheists and theists. Both the book and the film are extremely thought provoking and create "delicious food for thought" for all truth seekers. Come only if you want to stop and think, reflect and ponder.
